PURPOSE: To establish operating procedures, definitions, and assign responsibility for operations involving the Delta-Cardiff Volunteer Fire Company Ambulance Division

APPLICABLE TO: All Ambulance Division Operations

AUTHORITY: DCVFC Ambulance Committee

1. Applicability:

This procedure is applicable for all operations of the ambulance service of the Delta-Cardiff Volunteer Fire Company. Any phase of the ambulance operations not delineated in this procedure will be referred to the ambulance captain. The Delta-Cardiff Volunteer Fire Company Ambulance Committee will reconcile problems or definitions not resolved by the ambulance captain.

2. Responsibility:

Each person participating in the Delta-Cardiff Volunteer Fire Company Ambulance Division is responsible for compliance with applicable provisions of this procedure. The ambulance line officers, through guidance of the Delta-Cardiff Volunteer Fire Company Ambulance Committee, are responsible that only qualified persons, others in training, or those involved in a ride a long program are permitted on the ambulances, and that each person has been briefed in their duties, responsibilities, and precautions that must be observed
