SUBJECT: Issue of Pagers

DIVISION: Ambulance

INITIAL DATE: Unknown

PURPOSE: To define the procedure for issuance of pagers.

APPLICABLE TO: All Personnel

AUTHORITY: DCVFC Ambulance Committee

1. Each person who is actively involved in the emergency medical services of this company will be issued a pager.
2. Pagers shall be capable of receiving on Med 10 (462.975mHz).
3. In the event there are not sufficient pagers for all active personnel, the following will be used to determine the distribution criteria.
  - A. Call volume.
  - B. Level of certification.
  - C. Crew Status (driver, aid, trainee).
6. The ambulance captain shall have the authority to pull any pager.
7. The ambulance captain shall have the authority to recall any pager for maintenance at any time.
8. Any person who meets the qualifications to be issued a pager and is denied by the ambulance captain may appeal to the ambulance committee of this company.
9. A case will be provided with each pager. The pager must be carried in the case at all times. Repeated failure to comply will result in the loss of pager, not to exceed 30 days for the first offense.

10. In the event a pager is lost or stolen, the ambulance division will pay the deductible specified for the first time loss only. Any subsequent losses, the individual is responsible for any such deductible, provided all provisions of this procedure are met.
