SUBJECT: Ambulance Vehicle, Equipment & Supplies

DIVISION: Ambulance

INITIAL DATE: 26 June 2003

EFFECTIVE DATE: 23 February 2004

PURPOSE: To establish a policy for vehicles, equipment, and supplies.

APPLICABLE TO: All EMS Personnel

AUTHORITY: DCVFC Ambulance Committee

1. All ambulances shall meet 75 PA, C.S. §§4571 and 4572 (relating to visual and audible signals on emergency vehicles; and visual signals on authorized vehicles) and 67 PA Code Chapter 173 (relating to flashing or revolving lights on emergency and authorized vehicles), and the federal KKK standards which were in effect at the time of the vehicle's manufacture and which are not inconsistent with the Vehicle Code standards in 75 PA C.S. §§4571 and 4572. These specifications will be for design types, floor plans, and general configuration and exterior markings.
2. All vehicles shall carry medical equipment and supplies as published by the Department of Health in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
3. All equipment and supplies shall be readily available and in working order.
4. All personnel are responsible for reporting any broken, malfunctioning, or missing inventory or equipment (including any problems with the vehicle) to an EMS officer.
5. All personnel are responsible for restocking and cleaning the unit after each call. It is recommended that each duty crew check the unit prior to beginning their duty tour.
6. When a vehicle is replaced, the Department of Health's (DOH) Modification of Ambulance Fleet Form shall be completed and forwarded to the Regional Council as per DOH guidelines.
